Incorporate any of 6,000 learning objects into your quizzes, or use them to animate corresponding lesson plans created with Notebook. Formative and summative assessment

- Radio frequency technology The radio frequency technology (RF) for the Senteo interactive response system remote is reliable and convenient. You don't need a line of sight to deliver questions or send answers, and the remote has a range of up to 100 ft. (30 m).
- Large LCD screen The large screen is easy to read and has room to display three lines of text. Students can scroll through questions and find out instantly if their responses have been sent.
- Descriptive icons Conveniently displayed icons on the LCD screen tell students the battery power and network status.
- Ergonomic design The handheld remote is designed to fit comfortably in young hands, and the 21
 input buttons are conveniently located and easy to use.
- Extended battery life Each remote uses two AA batteries, which are long-lasting and easy to replace.

- Convenient maintenance features LED lights indicate power status and whether information has been sent or received.



Software

The Senteo interactive response system is fully integrated with SMART's Notebook software, so it links you to numerous education resources.

Notebook software resources

• Use the graphic-rich learning objects available in Notebook software to build dynamic questions with images and other multimedia content.

Flexible assessment options

 Compile tests for formative and summative assessment. The Senteo interactive response system allows you to prepare quizzes in advance and ask ad-hoc questions to gauge students' knowledge level at any point during a lesson.

Question variety

 Ask different types of questions, including true or false, yes or no, multiple choice, numeric response and more-than-one right answer. You can also incorporate decimals, fractions and negative numbers into questions.

Instant feedback

 Find out instantly how well students have understood what you've taught them. You can choose to get feedback in a bar graph or pie chart that summarizes the results from one question or all of them. You can also see responses from individual students to help you personalize learning.

Import and export using other software

 Senteo allows you to export quiz answers to Excel® spreadsheet software for use with gradebook software.

Print quizzes and study guides

 Senteo allows you to print quizzes as handouts so students can complete them at their own pace. You can also print test summaries showing individual students which questions they answered correctly or incorrectly. The summaries can be enhanced with teacher comments and used as study guides.
